

## *Family Life Center*

### **Guidelines for Attire:**

The Family Life Center is an extension of the Ministry of Fairview Baptist Church to help the ministry of reaching people for Jesus Christ, our Lord and Savior. Because of the desire to honor God in every aspect of our lives, Fairview asks that you adhere to the following areas of our visible witness as you participate in this ministry in all areas of the Family Life Center and on all church grounds.

### **Modesty as Our Model:**

In the interest of influencing others for Christ, clothing must be modest and in accordance with the highest Christian standards.

We ask that you only wear proper sports shoes when playing sports in the gym area. Cleats, turf shoes, and black-soled shoes are not permitted. Note please:

**Black soled-shoes are NOT permitted while playing sports.**

All shorts must be just above the knee,, fingertip length and loose fitting. If shorts are not fingertip length, leggings must be worn under the shorts. Anyone wearing tights, leotards, leggings, or spandex, must wear loose fitting shorts or a wrap over those clothing items.

Tight fitting clothes, revealing tops, or shirts with narrow straps are inappropriate and are not permitted in the Family Life Center. All sleeveless shirt straps must equal at the width of two (2) fingers.

Under garments such as sports bras, boxers, and underwear should not be visible. The participant's torso is to be covered at all times. Midriff may not be exposed.

T-shirts advocating alcohol, cigarettes/tobacco, or gangs are not consistent with Christian standards and are not allowed. Foul or offensive language displayed on T-shirts is not permitted.

No profanity

No smoking

No fighting

No knives

No guns unless permitted.

Children must be accompanied by an adult, group, or parents

## **Taking Care of the Building So All Can Enjoy:**

1. No balls are to be thrown against the walls or any other objects.
2. No tape will be put on the walls in the gym area or in hallways of education area.
3. No sporting equipment is to be taken out of the building unless noted by *Activity Director*.
4. All sporting equipment should be put back into its proper place after it has been used.
5. All lights must be turned off before leaving the building.
6. Lights during the day in the gym may not be needed because of the windows in the top on each side of the building. This may provide sufficient lighting for your activity. Please do not turn on lights if they are not needed.
7. If you chew gum or have drinks, please put them in the trash cans when you are finished with them. No cans, bottles, or cups should be left lying around. Chewing gum or candy does not need to be stuck to anything BUT the inside of the trash can!
8. Do not try to kick a ball of any kind toward the ceiling. It could make a hole or dent or may cause a light fixture to fall and someone could get hurt.
9. We ask that you please abide by these rules. This building is a part of God's house and should be respected as such.
